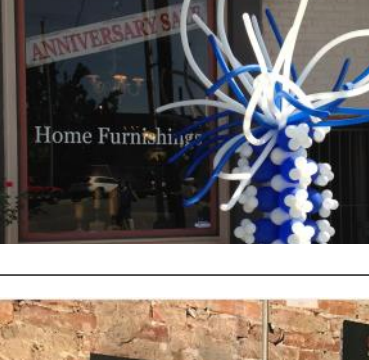

FARMERS' MARKET OPENS MAY 22

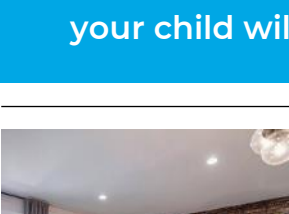
The Phoenix Hill NULU Farmers' Market is opening for its 12th Season on Tuesday, May 22nd. The Market is open every Tuesday, from 3-6PM through the end of October. Located in the parking lot of Fresh Start Growers' Supply, at 1007 East Jefferson Street, there is plenty of free, on-site parking. (The space is provided through the generosity of Fresh Start Growers Supply, Jim Phillips Remodeling and Restoration, Harshaw Trane, Climb NULU, and Hunt Properties.)

Andrew Abbott (Brooklyn, NY) lets it be known: I don't live between two worlds because worlds aren't like sheets. I live in world soup. In that soup are all our personal worlds, and Abbott paints that soup. Abbott received his BA in Studio Art from the University of North Carolina, was born in Nova Scotia, grew up in North Carolina, served in the U.S. Army as a medic, and has lived in Georgia, Maine, Canada, and Puerto Rico.

Tedi Doychinova reviewed Abbott's 2014 show for LEO.

Suann Childers (Lexington, KY) paints an extended allegory of a joyous, free but imperiled place called Clown Island, which is a little of New York City and other places Childer lived before returning to Lexington. Childers also paints the Four Horsemen, in ways that predate but vibrate with the contemporary struggles of the Water Keepers at Standing Rock. Childers has an MFA from Washington University in the Saint Louis School of Art, and an MA from the Rhode Island School of Design.

C.J. PRESSMA is a graduate of Antioch College and holds an M.F.A. in Photography from Indiana University. He studied as a special graduate student with Minor White at MIT and with Henry Holmes Smith at Indiana University. In 1970 he founded the Center for Photographic Studies—an alternative school of creative photography. The Center provided a full-time learning experience for those seeking to explore photography as creative expression. Its two galleries provided monthly photographic exhibits featuring the works of local, regional, and internationally acclaimed photographic artists. In 1979 Pressma embarked on a career as a multimedia producer and marketing communications specialist. In 1984, his seven part series Witness to the Holocaust, was released in the U.S. and Canada where it remains in distribution today. One of the first productions to use survivor interviews as the exclusive content to tell the story of the Holocaust, Witness to the Holocaust has received numerous national awards. In December, 2001 Pressma was awarded an Al Smith Fellowship by the Kentucky Arts Council. Also In 2001 Pressma was selected as one of 84 artists worldwide for the landmark exhibition Digital Printmaking Now at the Brooklyn Museum of Art. Pressma's career includes numerous solo and group exhibitions in the United States, Canada, and Ireland. His work is included in the collections of the Speed Art Museum, The University of Louisville's Photographic Archive, and the National Gallery of Canada.
